

Water for All:

An Oneida Association Mission Project of Study, Advocacy and Service

Concept:

1. A gathering of groups and individuals from Oneida Association Churches with a desire to engage in concrete ways to address issues of eco-justice regarding the conservation and distribution of water.
2. Through a program of study, fellowship, advocacy and service participants will commit
 - a. to utilize the National Council of Churches Resource, "Water Stewards: A Toolkit for Congregational Care of Local Watersheds" for study, behavioral modification and advocacy;
 - b. to raise money to fund well for a community in Kenya provided by Church World Service; and
 - c. to attend in four gatherings of all participants for mutual sharing and fellowship

Goal:

Raise at least \$3,100 to provide for a Church World Service installed well in a community in Kenya.

Purpose:

1. Provide resources for local churches to strengthen their mission and to enhance the inter-congregational fellowship of the Association.
2. Lift up the concern, raise awareness and inspire individuals and congregations to find ways to conserve, renew, and share clean water – a limited natural resource.
3. Enlarge our worldview by providing a means by which our churches can actually help sisters and brothers in another part of the globe with a natural resource that we have in appropriate abundance.
